Note 2: There is no MTH 241 at OIT, but MTH 251 may be used to satisfy this requirement (take MTH112 as prerequisite first).

Note 3: Students admitted to OSU's College of Business with OSU catalog year 2020/21 or later will need to follow our Business curriculum above. Some class requirements have changed from prior years. Talk with an advisor if you have questions.

Note 4: MTH 362 will fulfill this requirement (MTH 361 is a pre-requisite for MTH 362)
