The Pre-Design core typically takes two years to complete. After completing the pre-professional program requirements, students may apply to the professional program during a spring term to begin pro-school the subsequent fall term.

Admission into the professional program is subject to a competitive application process. Students will not be permitted to take professional program coursework without acceptance into the program.

If accepted, a laptop will be required; please see the College of Business Advising website for specifications. To apply and be considered for admission, all pre-professional merchandising management students must meet the following requirements:

- Be declared as a Pre-Design major.
- Have a minimum OSU cumulative GPA of 2.5. Note: The average GPA of those who were accepted in the 2016 cohorts was 3.1 – 3.5
- Have received a C- or better in all courses.

The deadline for application materials to the professional program is **May 1**.
