ELIGIBILITY REQUIREMENTS TO DECLARE THE MINOR

To be eligible to declare the minor students must satisfy all of the following requirements:

- Complete the Minor online orientation.
- Be declared in a non-business major (exception is IMDD or Design)
- Have a C- or better in any completed Minor course (OSU or transferred). If a grade below a C- exists in a minor course, student must be enrolled to retake course at the time of application. The initial grade received, however, is used in the GPA for evaluation purposes.
- Have a Minor GPA of 2.5 or higher (OSU grades only) if completed any minor courses.
- Be in good standing at OSU with a 2.0 OSU cumulative GPA and a 2.0 GPA from the most recent term at OSU (OSU grades only).

REQUIREMENTS TO EARN THE MINOR

Students must satisfy all the requirements listed below:

- Completion of all Minor required classes with a C- or better in each class (A "C" or better in BA 352 and BA 390 is required)
- Completion of a minimum of 32 credits of approved Minor classes.
- Have a Minor GPA of 2.5 or higher (OSU grades ONLY).
- All Minor classes must be taken for a letter grade (A-F) you cannot S/U any of these classes.
- If retaking classes refer to the 'retaking courses' policy to see which grade will be used to compute the GPA

- At least 50% of the required classes used to satisfy the Minor requirements MUST be taken at OSU.
- 50% or more of the minor credits cannot also be part of another business minor being pursued
- Transfer classes that are equivalent may satisfy Minor requirements.
- Transfer classes used to satisfy any of the upper division Minor required classes must come from an AACSB accredited business school.

Important notes:

- The College of Business enforces prerequisites, including class standing prerequisites.
