Business majors complete common core requirements at the lower and upper division levels as well as courses specific to a major. Business majors include:

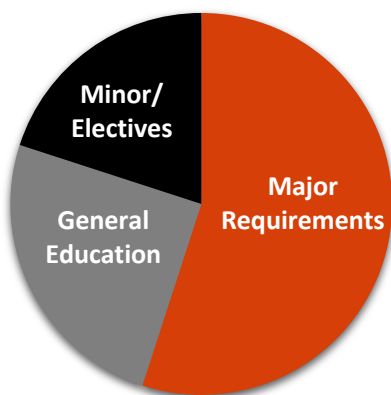

## Your Bachelor's Degree ([BA/BS/BFA) in the College of Business



- A minimum of 180 credits are required for graduation; 60 must be upper division (300 and 400-level courses).
- A maximum of 135 credits earned at a community college may be applied toward a bachelor's degree at OSU.
- Only courses with letter prefixes and numbers above 100 can be accepted.

## Important Notes & Resources

### Resources and OSU Information:

- Students do not have to complete a transfer degree in order to transfer to OSU.
  - If you've completed the Oregon AAOT or ASOT, all lower division Bacc Core/Core Ed requirements are considered complete.
  - If you've completed to CTM (Core Transfer Map) or an MTM (Major Transfer Map), all lower division Bacc Core/Core Ed requirements are considered complete except Difference, Power and Oppression Foundations.
