Dates and Deadlines

OSU's academic year has four quarters, or **terms**, rather than semesters. You can attend OSU for 1-3 terms, in either Fall, Winter or Spring, depending on the agreement we have with your university.

The application deadline varies, depending on which term you are applying to start the exchange program:

Fall Term 2023

27 September -
15 December 2023

Apply by
April 1, 2023

Winter Term 2024

8 January –
22 March 2024

Apply by
October 1, 2023

Spring Term 2024

01 April –
14 June 2024

Apply by
January 1, 2024

*Exchange students do **not** normally attend OSU in summer term but check with your home school coordinator to see if that is an option.*

All exchange students must plan to arrive about **one week before** the first day of the term, as we will welcome all exchange students at the mandatory Orientation meeting before classes begin.

You should expect to stay on campus until the last day of term, as you may have a final exam on that day.

Information for incoming international exchange students

Student Fees

No **tuition fees** are charged to students coming to OSU in the College of Business exchange program.

General fees that are charged to all students cost approximately **US\$750.00** per term. These fees include access to recreational facilities, involvement in clubs, use of the Corvallis transit system, and other on-campus student services that you will use.

Health Insurance

All exchange students are required to have full health insurance whilst attending OSU. Most students purchase health insurance directly from OSU, this will cost approximately **US\$1350.00** per term.

Sometimes it is possible to request a waiver, but **only** if you can provide evidence of having the same level of health insurance coverage from your home country.

English Language Skills

Exchange students are required to have advanced English language skills for OSU Business courses. Your home university will confirm your English proficiency as part of your application (TOEFL waiver form). We do not offer preparatory English Language courses before the start of the term.

Accommodation

Living on campus

OSU student housing options vary, depending on residence hall and sharing a room. Prices range from US\$2025-\$4800 per term. A dining plan will cost about US \$900-\$1500 per term. If you cancel your exchange after signing a housing contract with OSU, you may be required to pay cancellation fees, ranging from \$200 to the full term housing cost, depending on when you cancel the contract.

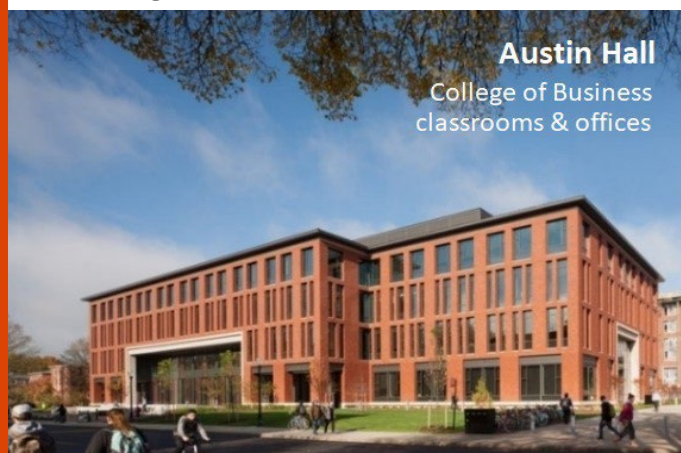
